Digital Citizenship

An important component of e-Learning is remembering to demonstrate positive Digital Citizenship skills when online. The Sunnybrae Digital Citizenship Poster developed by our e-Learning Team has been included on the reverse of this newsletter for you to review with your child.

Google Apps for Education (GAPE)

This year Sunnybrae has continued to make progress with the use of GAPE - or Google Apps for Education.

Google Apps for Education

Google Apps are a web-based suite of applications to support collaboration and communication. The Google services include communication tools (email, Google Talk), productivity tools (Google Docs: word processing, spreadsheets, and presentations) and Google Sites (to develop web pages).

Year 3-6 students have been given their own email address and can create and upload files. Permission levels have been set and can allow other students to read, amend, and add content to files from any computer that has a web browser and internet access.

Sunnybrae staff and students have continued to develop their confidence and use of GAPE this year.

GAPE has helped ensure access and collaboration with school related documents, timetables and planning. This has been particularly helpful when working with student teachers.

Our students enjoy the opportunity to collaborate and share when creating documents and presentations and to later have them presented on the classroom blog. Please remember to check out our work and leave a blog comment as students enjoy reviewing the feedback.


Digital Portfolios
