

Sunnybrae Normal School Bike Licence Contract

Accepting my Bike Licence means that when riding my bike I will always:

- wear a helmet
- wear shoes
- wear a visibility vest
- use the correct hand signals
- obey New Zealand road rules including riding on the correct side of the road
- ride in a manner that is safe for me and other road or footpath users
- get off at the entrance to school and walk my bike in the school grounds
- leave my bike alone during school hours
- remember I have my bike at school for my use and I will not lend it to others during or after school.

My parents and I have read the Sunnybrae Road Safety Policy (on the school website). If I break any part of this contract my parents will be notified, I will hand my licence back to the school and I will no longer have the privilege of riding my bike to school.
