This has now created a vacancy on the Sunnybrae Normal School Board, so we are searching for a replacement. In situations like this, the board has the authority to appoint whomever they see fit unless 10% or more of the parent community request there is a by-election, and if there is more than one person that expresses an interest in serving on the board.

So what does a parent member on the Board of Trustees do? The board helps set and maintain the strategic direction of the school and acts in the best interests of the whole school from a parent's perspective. They support the principal, who leads the day-to-day management of the school. Board members review school policies and serve on various committees, such as finance, property, communications and human resources. On average, this requires about 3 - 5 hours a month.

Sunnybrae Uniform Guideline

Having a uniform fosters school pride and self-esteem in students. It promotes the culture of the School and visibility in the community.

The wearing of the uniform at school is compulsory for all students. Please make sure it is clearly named. The correct uniform is to be worn in its entirety and must be in good condition; clean and in good repair. Items worn for additional warmth during winter terms underneath polo shirts must not be visible.

Students are required to wear the uniform at special school events outside school hours. Students are required to wear the sports uniform for representative games and at inter-zone sports meetings.

The uniform consists of Sunnybrae Normal School: - Polo shirt with long sleeves (black) or short sleeves (yellow) with Sunnybrae logo - Full-zip polar fleece with Sunnybrae logo - Black shorts, skort, or trousers with Sunnybrae logo - Shoes or sandals that are predominantly black (no boots or jandals) - Black or white socks/tights - Black or white headbands/ties only may be worn - P.E./Sports Tee with Sunnybrae logo - School jacket with Sunnybrae logo. Bucket hat with Sunnybrae logo (Terms 1 and 4) - Plain black beanie (Terms 2 and 3)

Students who arrive at school incorrectly dressed should have a note from their parent/caregiver that explains why this is the case.

In Zone Enrolment

If you live 'in zone' and have a child turning 5 this year, **please make sure you enrol your child/children as soon as possible**. Please also encourage any new 'in zone' families to enrol their children as this helps us with future planning. Please visit our website www.sunnybrae.school.nz and complete the enrolment form. If you are moving away from Sunnybrae, please contact the office as soon as possible.

Out of Zone Ballot for Entry

Enrolment at Sunnybrae Normal School is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available from the school office. Students who live within the home zone are entitled to enrol at the school.

For students who live out of zone, the next opportunity to apply is before **Monday 29 May 2023**, this will be for students starting between 17 July and 22 September 2023 in Year 0, Year 1, Year 2, Year 3 and Year 4 for out of zone students.

There will be an out of zone ballot held on Monday 5 June 2023 for students not living in the school's home zone. If the number of out of zone applications exceeds the number of places available, students will be selected by ballot. Parents will be informed of the outcome of the ballot within three school days of the ballot being held.


